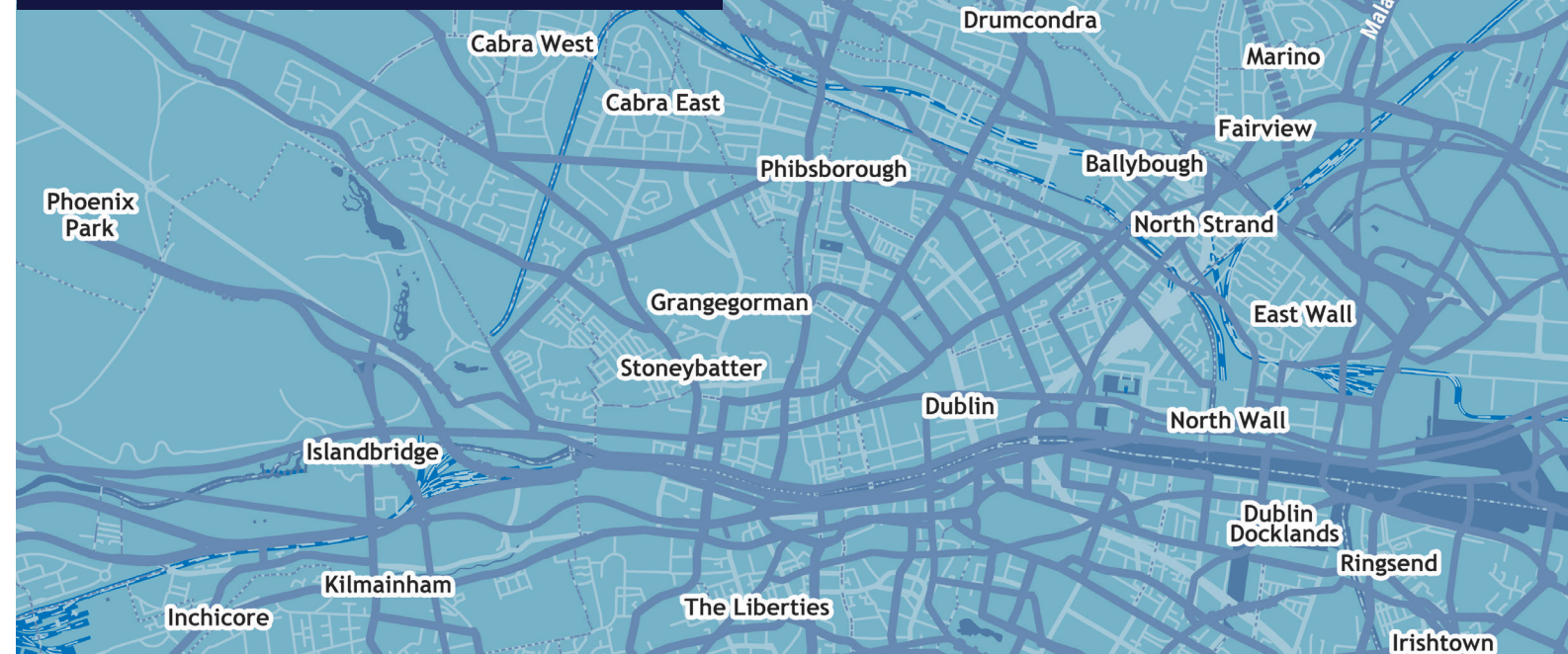
HOW DO YOU FIND US?

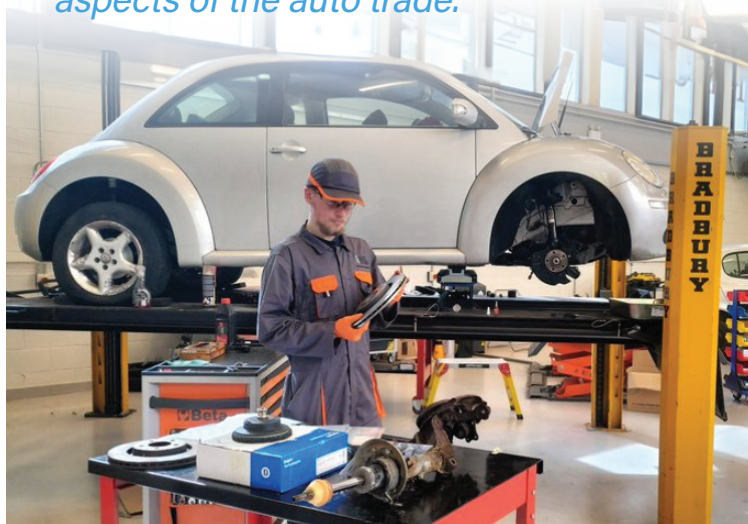

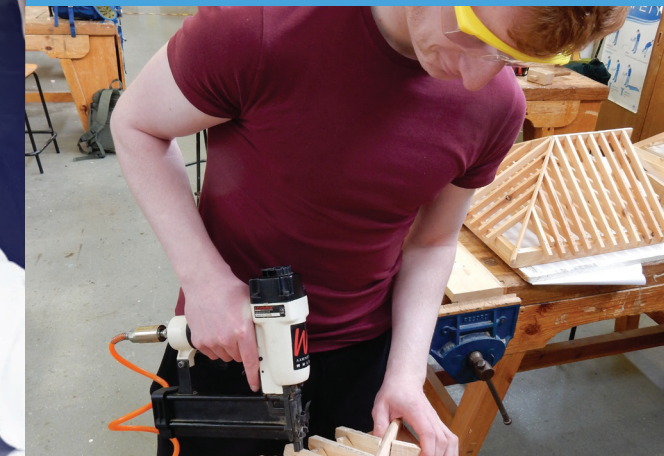

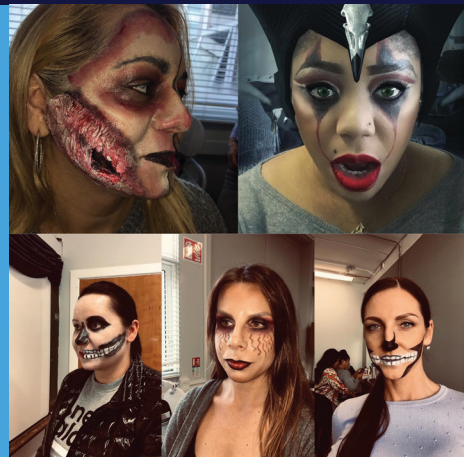
